

PUBPOINT VERSION 2.5 ANNOUNCED

Based on customer feedback, MNT Systems enhanced PubPoint and is proud to announce the release of PubPoint™ 2.5. This release is officially available today, October 29th.

The improvements provide increased content author productivity and simplified tool navigation.

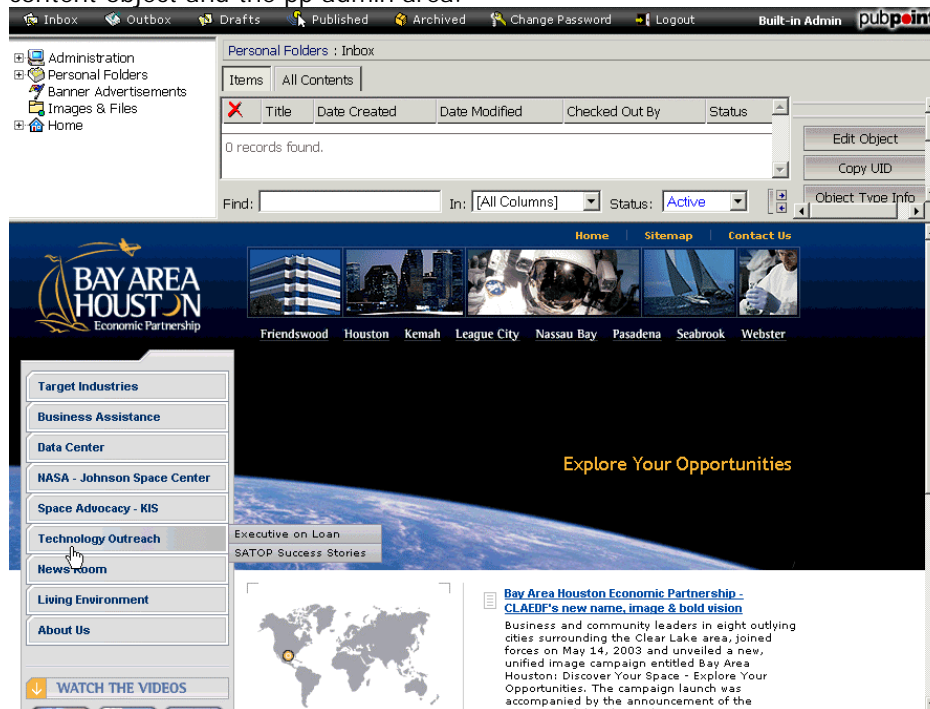
The following modules have been enhanced:

- **a NEW RSVP module is added.**

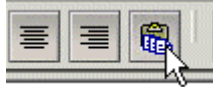
Improved Core Features

- Content searches are simplified

The admin area now provides a panel with a "front end" view in which the PubPoint administrator can surf to locate the content he/she needs to edit. This enhancement simplifies finding content that requires changes. The PubPoint administrator can resize the bottom panel, depending on need. Administration tree navigation now takes the PubPoint administrator author to the bottom of the page. The bottom area of the administration tree provides access to the content object in the pp admin area. This strengthens the correlation between the content object and the pp admin area.



- Improvements to Wysiwyg Content Editor - Clean and Paste Toolbar Button.
This enhancement permits content owners to paste content directly from Microsoft Word™ automatically removing all embedded styling attributes.



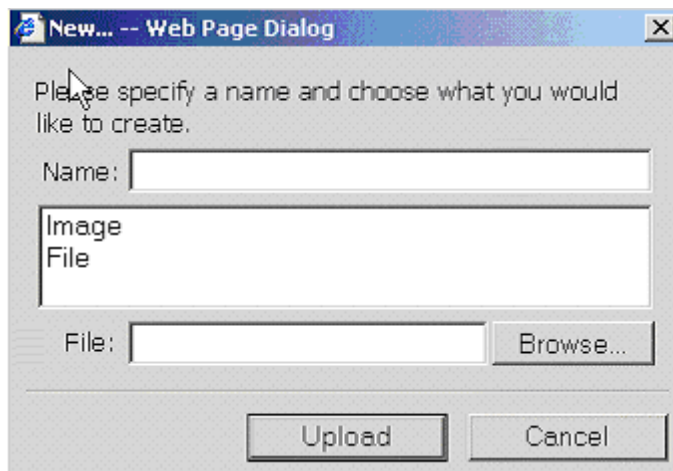
- Easier Content management.

An "X" is now displayed in content view for quick deletion of objects.

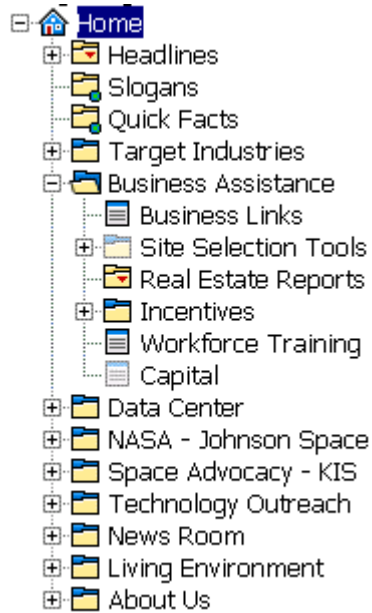
- Easier File and Image uploading

Files and images can be stored in one central gallery and the steps to upload are simpler.




- New object icons

New tree icons clearly specify the behavior of the content sections.

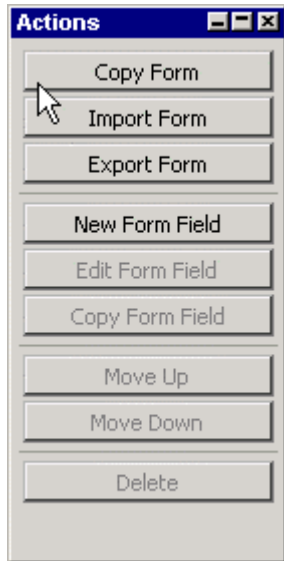


- *Editable Meta Description and Meta Tag*
 This powerful new feature permits PubPoint administrators to update the Meta Description and Meta Keywords of the site, which improves search engine positioning.



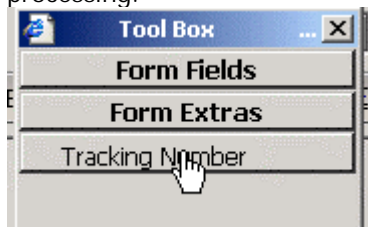
Improvements to the Form Module

- *Export and Import web forms*
 Forms created in PubPoint can be now exported to a file. This enables sharing of forms with other PubPoint-administrated sites. Form export can be used also to create base form templates as a starting point for new forms.



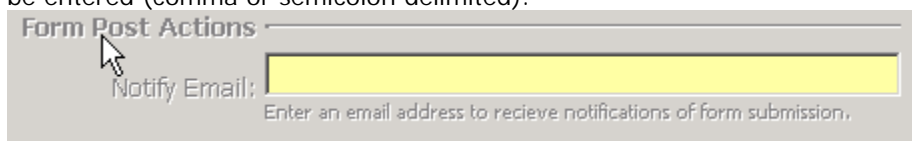
- *New Tracking Feature*

Auto email notifications now contain tracking numbers, so the data and form email can be matched. The tracking number can be used for transaction processing.

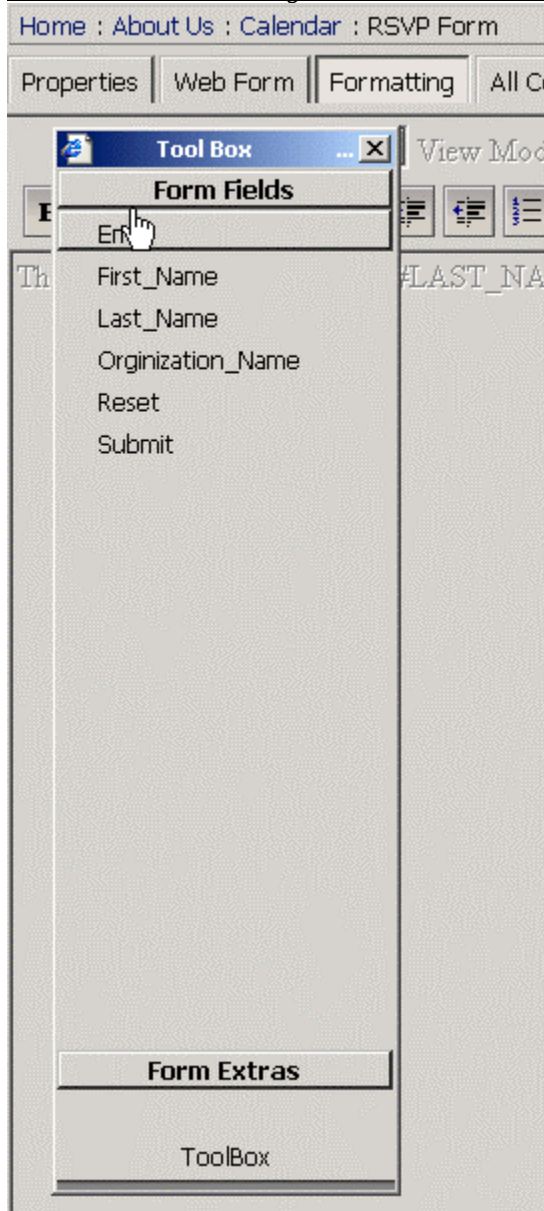


- *New notification option*

The "to address" in the form module was modified to permit multiple form administrator notifications. This permits multiple email notification addresses to be entered (comma or semicolon delimited).



- New Toolbox for building custom email notifications

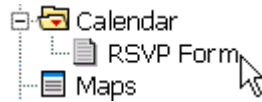


- Bug Fixes
 - Form Fields names can now contain spaces.
 - Excel data view works with Excel 2002.
 - Form fields names can be tagged as "NOSAVE" so they will not be saved to the database.

New RSVP Module










This module provides an events section with RSVP functionality. The content author can add events as needed. Site visitors will select one or multiple events, complete an associated form with their contact information, and submit. The contact information, as well as the list of events they selected, is sent to an

appropriate recipient. The list of events is filtered by date to not display events with event dates in the past.
